• Chapter Ten Exam, Question 6 contains a typo for the "B" answer. The "B" answer should read:

B. b.depositMoney(100);

• Chapter Twelve, Lesson Two on page 206 incorrectly identifies the default selection mode for the **JList** control:

"By default, the **JList** will only allow a user to select one item from the list."

The default selection mode for a **JList** is actually "ListSelectionModel.MULTIPLE_INTERVAL_SELECTION".

So by default, multiple items can be selected from a **JList** at one time.

- The Chapter Test for Chapter 14 contains a question (#8) with no correct answer. Please replace the question in its entirety with the following question and answers. The test answer in the answer key remains the same.
 - 8. What is one advantage the Sequential Search has over Binary Search?
 - A. Sequential search is faster
 - B. Sequential search will work over unsorted data
 - C. Sequential search can be implemented with recursion
 - **D.** None of these are true
- Chapter Sixteen, Activity One: The JailBreak activity starter project contains a "GameBoard.java" class that implements some of the game logic for the student. This class contains a bug that will result in the visual display of columns and rows getting switched...so a piece at column 1, row 5 will display as (5,1) in the toString() method instead of (1,5).
