



LTI 1.3 Integrations for Schoology – **Not Supported**

For many years, CompuScholar has supported standard LTI 1.0 integrations. To configure a host platform like Schoology with LTI 1.0, district administrators simply need a **Consumer Key** and **Secret Key** provided by CompuScholar. All CompuScholar materials are integrated into a host LMS integrations through Common Cartridge imports, as described in our Integrations page. This fast, convenient process allows teachers or administrators to set up an entire course automatically, including the organization of materials into Chapter and Lesson folder structures, creating native Schoology quizzes and tests from embedded QTI content, etc.

CompuScholar now also offers LTI 1.3 support to take advantage of **Dynamic Registration** and the **Assignment and Grade Services (AGS)**. Unfortunately, Schoology does not support two key features that make an LTI 1.3 deployment feasible and worthwhile:

1. Schoology does not support the LTI 1.3 Assignment and Grades Service (AGS) for gradable activity links imported through Common Cartridge. Therefore, we are unable to write student grades back to the Schoology gradebook when using LTI 1.3 for materials imported through Common Cartridge.

Note: Schoology supports LTI 1.3 “Deep Linking” as the only mechanism to link externally gradable LTI 1.3 resources into a course. Deep Linking is far inferior to Common Cartridge in this context, as it does not support folder structures to organize materials, nor the creation of native Schoology assessments from QTI content.

2. The main advantage of upgrading from LTI 1.0 to LTI 1.3 is the ability to notify teachers through the AGS when a submitted assignment needs manual teacher grading. Schoology does not support teacher notifications of submitted assignments from External Tools. Therefore, there is no advantage to upgrading from LTI 1.0 to LTI 1.3.

We value our Schoology customers and hope that Schoology will eventually add these important features. Our LTI 1.3 support is ready and waiting when they do! In the meantime, **simply continue to use LTI 1.0** as documented on our Integrations page.
