## **Third Edition Errata Sheet**

This document lists the known typographical or other corrections to the *KidCoder™: Windows Programming* Third Edition course.

- In the optional instructional videos on Chapter 4, Lesson 1, several data types such as “Integer”, “Long”, and “Short” are incorrectly labeled against the corresponding numeric ranges. The student textbook on page 55 “Integer Types” correctly lists the name of each data type and the corresponding range.
- In the optional instructional videos on Chapter 4, Lesson 3, towards the end of the video a “screencast” will finish the audio and then show additional video for 30-60 seconds. There is no missing audio; the screencast video should have ended at the same time as the audio. You can simply ignore or bypass the silent area.
- In the Chapter 5 test, question #9 about clearing a TextBox control is out of place; TextBox controls are not discussed until Chapter Six. Please replace the question entirely with the new question below (the correct answer letter remains the same):

**9. How would you declare and initialize a variable to hold the current date and time?**

- A. Dim currentTime As DateTime = DateTime.Now**
  - B. Dim currentTime As Date = Time.Now**
  - C. Dim currentTime As Integer = Now.DateTime**
  - D. Dim currentTime As Timestamp = DateTime**
